5year Plan

This five year strategic plan is guided by the vision to create a better future. It is anchored in the mission to upgrade quality and impart students overall development and enhance society through impactful education and research. The plan is framed around vision and mission of the institution.

1. NAAC accreditation in academic year 2017-2018.
2. To start vocation educational courses for Undergraduates academic year 2018- 2019.
3. NBA accreditation in academic year 2018- 2019.
4. Apply to JNTUH for NOC for autonomous status and to submit the application to UGC in academic year 2018-2019.
5. Introduction of PG courses in all departments by 2019-20.
6. Minimum 30 % of faculty with Ph.D. qualification by the year 2020 & 50% by 2022. In order to achieve the above, faculties will be encouraged to register for the Ph.D. and to complete in the given stipulated period.
7. The faculty is motivated for research publication in Scopus Journal or UGC approved journals.
8. Each department will be filing minimum one patent/IPR during the academic year 2018-2019 for UG and PG courses. For the year 2019-20 two patents filing per department and converting at least two filed patents into final award, For the year 2020-21, four patents filing per department and converting at least four filed patents into final award, For the year 2021-22, six patents filing per department and converting at least six filed patents into final award.
9. Every department should have one project through consultancy:
 - 50% of faculty strength for year 2017-18.
 - 75% of faculty strength for year 2018-19.
 - 100% of faculty strength for year 2019-20.
