The talk started with the startup ecosystem, talking to very young dynamic personality his name is Mr. Ravi shakes Suraj his director at Wikipedia he started his journey in a very small village in Maharashtra and now he is handling India operations It is that he started working for Wikipedia as a student or volunteering for Wikipedia has stood it so. He thank Dr. Jera for being his mentor he remember from the dear joining from that thing not just for Wikipedia whenever it came to bringing modern technologists to India including TED conferences. TEDx events to Wikipedia have always been instrumental in supporting me as well as the entire TEDx and Wikipedia community so thank for that so almost like seven to eight years back started we keep it decided to open its first ever physical office in India and they launched something called as India Education Program.

This will be part of that program the doctor sir was also instrumental in envisioning that entire campaign and global education program in India it's been amazing journey that time just started joining the ISO volunteer and then eventually started interacting with various volunteer communities it's incredible like all of us speak languages different cultures but when it comes to sharing knowledge is connected with that one same goal. Like if know something and will go to any extent like translating it writing it for free of course without expecting anything in return so this feel very fortunate and part of this moment and now are a director and now 're a director at Wikipedia.

Wikipedia is special Wikipedia awareness scheme for the head get a few years right now because it's 10 times more traffic as compared to CDC WH or any other side and last year. This realize there is no not even a single platform in India at least for Wikipedians in India to talk and collaborate with each other so he spoke with couple of peoples in the US as well as the global community how are going to solve this and that's when we come up with this initiative called X worst it is a platform which gives tools resources financial non-financial resources to the volunteer communities as well as anyone who'd like to do a mere soldier in this Wikipedia world and then the real work is done by 70,000 plus volunteers he fulfills what they need so we shake have 70,000 volunteers span across the world yes at any given point of time minimum 70,000 people come online to Wikipedia these people are not paid by anyone these people are don't have any other ulterior motives these are passionate volunteers who weave some of all knowledge should be free an accessible to all so some are paid people who are working like are a employee of Wikipedia right so Wikipedia ecosystem is totally different there are user groups chapter like Ted TEDx.

Wikimedia Foundation all Wikimedia affiliates gets paid to edit Wikipedia what people can get to paid it or can ask for money is to do workshops do fundraising do partnerships so I'm mainly focused on fundraising and partnerships so that's the half Wikipedia the open source model anyone can edit Wikipedia same way Wikipedia is also democratic when it comes to the management tomorrow anyone can run for election and sit on about they can become a board member of Wikimedia Foundation which is a parent organization body apart from Wikimedia Foundation there are various actually yes there are local user groups chapter there are like Wikipedia so currently what is the footprint of the commedia global footprint in a sense global food is a fifth biggest website in the world Facebook Google Microsoft Yahoo.

Wikipedia all this software websites have more than 10,000 plus employees Wikipedia including all the affiliate we'll have around at least around 400 to 500 people that said and it is words 5th biggest website in terms of readership 4ku mid-nineteen itself we are getting somewhere around 3 to 4 million hits per article but when it comes to Wikipedia the authenticity of knowledge or at authenticity of description which is given on Vega is always questioned this challenge how actually go ahead an try to maintain the sanctity of that platform or sanctity of the post the content part of it so Wikipedia has very few basic rules first is notability many people say like oh who decides on first is notability who decides notability a press meteor scientific journals articles can say climb say 10floors is it notable does it belong on Wikipedia as compared to say climbed Mount Everest.

Wikipedia reverts it back to the original content and sometimes the wrong message or wrong content actually gets propagated on Wikipedia that's complain of many of the users of Wikipedia first of all Wikipedia as such we don't have any staff we don't have any officers we don't have any paid editors we keep away like people like and me if there are 10 lakh people watching a covet article per day that means any given second there at least 500 to 600 people out of 600 just need one person to see something is wrong they go and click on the edit button and then they can remove the information a simple thing is have just asked people how seen Wikipedia's logo.

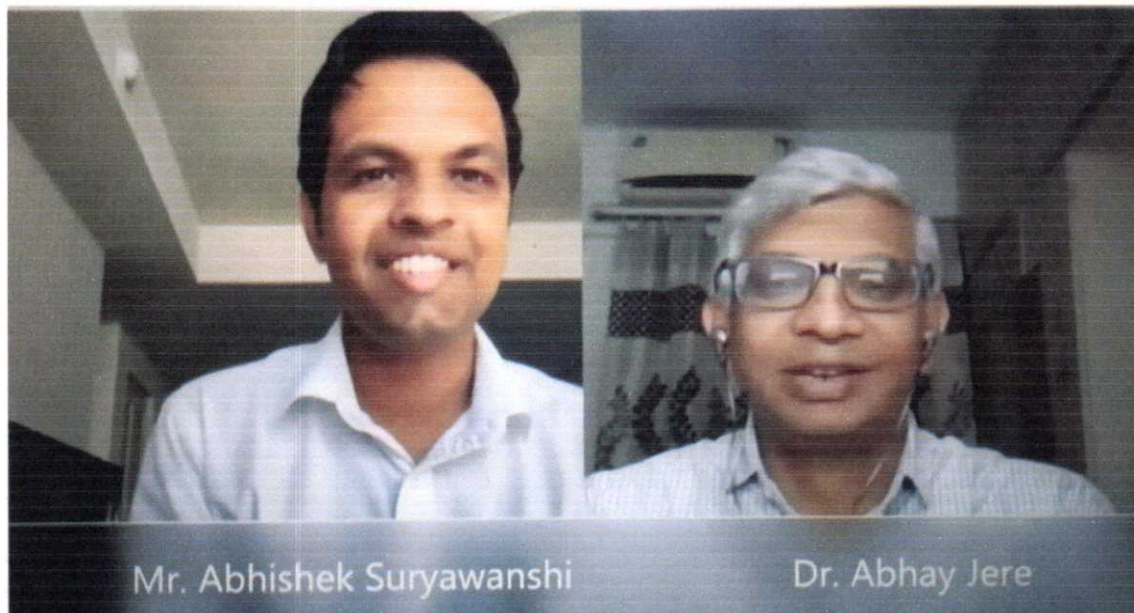
