Nilesh Oak holds BS & MS in Chemical Engineering and Executive MBA. He is interested in Astronomy, Archeology, Geology, Genetics, Quantum Mechanics, Economics, Ancient narratives and Philosophy. He published his first book, **‘When did the Mahabharata War Happen?: The Mystery of Arundhati’** in 2011.

He published his second book, **‘The Historic Rama – Indian Civilization at the end of Pleistocene’** in 2014. Both books are available in paperback and in Kindle on Amazon.

He is in the process of completing his third book, ‘Bhishma Nirvana

Dr. Nilesh is basically a chemical engineer used to work for a multinational like General Electric in US for about sixteen to seventeen years and was fascinated by Indian civilization history. Then he decided suddenly to quit his job and focus on unraveling the mysteries of Indian history.

He lived in America, North America, Canada, and USA for close to thirty years like he has spent more time in America than in India but he studied in India. He discussed about the American culture giving an example like in their mid-30s and mid-40s if we ask about the country but they still say it is the best country in the world. In spite they have this conviction right or wrong and, in that case, they say it's actually a right conviction because some of the dating things that America has one over the years in terms of innovation. The best that conviction is there now it brings back the twenty-four thousand years of the pure civilization it is a grand narrative in case of India. This will say it doesn't need any synthetically to create a grand narrative because it already exists and comprehend the role of a grand narrative as like in India. The Americans for the whole world as a humanity it gave the confidence of talking about twenty-four thousand years of Indian civilization even there are large in number of other Indo experts talking about 5,000 -7,000 years. He discussed the summary of Mahabharata in 1995 parallelly he was working in corporate job and had published a book later he left the company the full-time job and started reading Mahabharata he could extract 300-plus astronomy references and solve a jigsaw puzzle the problem-solving, it took 2 specific years and no other years like 5561 BC more than 7500 years ago. He did the same thing for a Mayan he found more than 600 references in the Valmiki Ramayana and solved a jigsaw puzzle it took 2 more years. The 14,000 years ago then in 2016 another professor from America suggested to work on dating of the weather and he did not get any help in astronomy from that field of astronomy. But the evidence from the Saraswathi river and other rivers 19 rivers of India based on that the geology, hydrology data 24,000 actually it is the lower side the oceanography, geology, geophysics, hydrology, seismology and genetics from some area evidence of timeline and actually it goes way back for example agriculture goes back to like as far back as 43,000 BC.

The example in the Raga whether there is a mention of a queen Vish Paulo and you know then mention of evidence and you can find this even this is made it to Wikipedia believe it or not usually good stuff about India. The dental surgery there is an evidence of Dental Surgery in the Indus-Saraswathi civilization what people will call IVC but its right name should be Indus-Saraswati civilization and that actually means the drilling of the teeth and then the filling and so the timing of this is 5,000 to 7,000 BC this is a surgery not many people may know or some

people may know is the whole discipline of surgery that Association in England it started after reports came from India. About the nose surgery or a nose know we call as plastic surgery so to say rhinoplasty the evidence came from India and it was not a textual evidence actually two British men saw a operation being performed on the streets of Pune in 1794 around that and that started the whole discipline in the west.

He elaborates on Surya Siddhanta just to give you a Gaynor there are more many updates to Surya Siddhanta going back to 17,500 years 14,500 BC. Surya Siddhanta have to go back another 20,000 before that so that's the kind of baseline but now what we are talking now in terms of the precision and accuracy what you'll find is the very fact we can detect these specific instances. Likewise, some things happened 3000 BC 5300 BC 7500 BC 12,000 BC 14,500 BC these are the epics books of making corrections. He explained about the illustration of a nakshatras, its measurements the longitudes and latitudes now the longitudes kind of change very fast because of the precision of equinoxes when I say very fast every thousand years you know that's fast in astronomy you know but if you go back to the latitudes of nakshatra the way they are given in Surya Siddhanta verses they the way their measurements are today what doctor Anil narnun did just a seriously dumb example so unless you are talking about twenty four thousand of years of Indian civilization there are other experts we spoke about five thousand seven thousand years of Indian history of Indian civilization history. Astro there are many as science disciplines but astronomy is one discipline which can give very precise answers.

He concluded with the example quoted that it is attributed to Einstein he said if you have a one-hour spend close to 45 minutes defining the problem and then use last 10 15 minutes solving it if you have got the right problem this solution would emerge more like mixing of a buttermilk and the butter comes to the top but many times what happens sometimes people do something and that may not have any relevance to the society so always start with a while and spend enough time and then act very fast. Like Rama going to Lanka for example once he decided that's the course of action they went the success or failure that's not in our hand so why to act swiftly and that's what we can get this wisdom from the past is because if you don't act swiftly then the situation changes so the solution that you make him come up with either somebody else would come up with that.

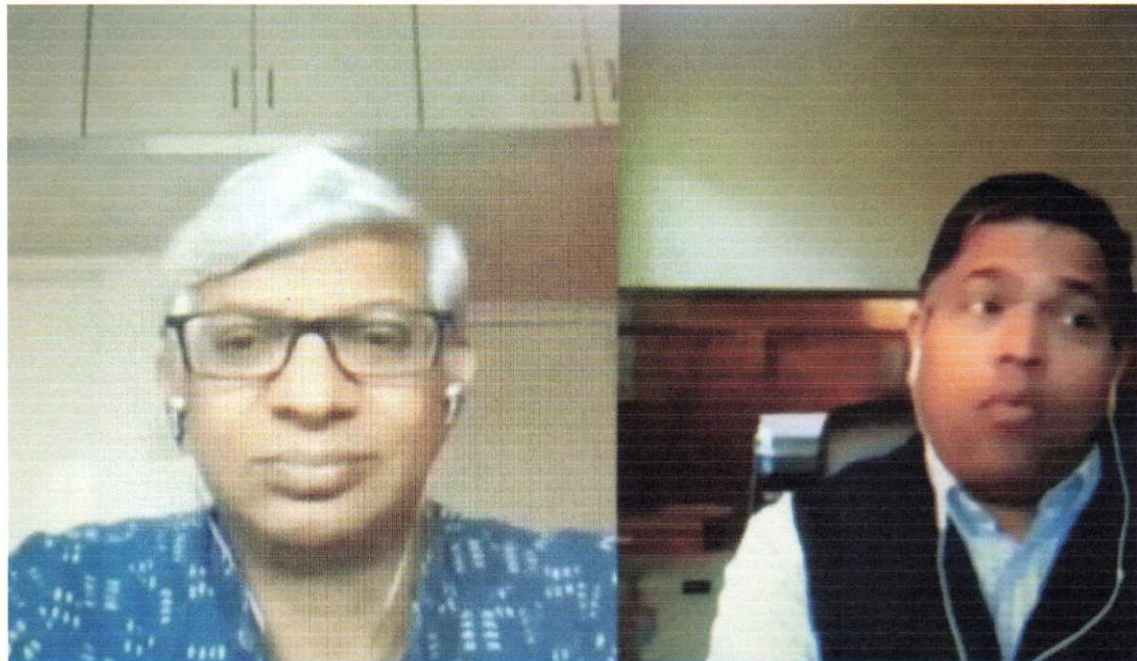
