Mr. DipendraManocha is founder of an organization named “Saksham Trust” for developing solutions and promoting digital literacy. The shift of using online platforms for various webinars due to COVID-19 outbreak has changed the ways of reaching students and utilization of more digital tools in education has crept in. “Saksham Trust” is presently having partnership with Professor Bala Krishnan of IIT Delhi and a dedicated lab is set up for developing technological solutions especially for Divyangjan (differently abled persons). He is working with the DAISY Consortium which is working in the area of providing publications in accessible formats to persons who cannot read normal print. He is the lead of training and technical support and coordinates DAISY Consortium’s projects in developing countries. He is the president of the DAISY Forum of India which is a network of more than 130 organizations in India serving the persons with blindness and low vision. He is president of the National Association for the Blind. He also worked as consultant to the Delhi University for establishing the resource center for persons with disability. He worked as resource person in series of workshops on accessible built environment conducted by the Chief Commissioner Disabilities, Govt. of India. He is an Ashoka Fellow and has received National Award from the president of India in the year 2005 and 2007 for his work and leadership role.

1. Shri DipendraManocha suggested everyone to inculcate various traits and values in their life for achieving better leadership skills and also to achieve goals that they have set for themselves.
2. He guided all to focus on the core values which will help to fulfil the goals, told them to think wisely and in a unique manner that should make a difference.
3. He also guided all to think creatively, do things in a different manner and make plans accordingly to achieve something.
4. He stated that one should look for long term sustainability which will lead towards larger benefits in the long run. He also discussed the importance of positive mindset and said that making positive changes in your attitude increases your vibrancy and energy.
4. He elaborated and stated that this strengthened positivity gives you increased courage and persistence to explore new areas of life. He also stated that leadership skills will develop only

with practice and experience. He also said that to be a good leader, it's very important to think innovatively as it keeps your mind skills fresh and prepares you for new challenges that may come your way. important
