3. What the internet did for communication, blockchain will do for trusted transaction.

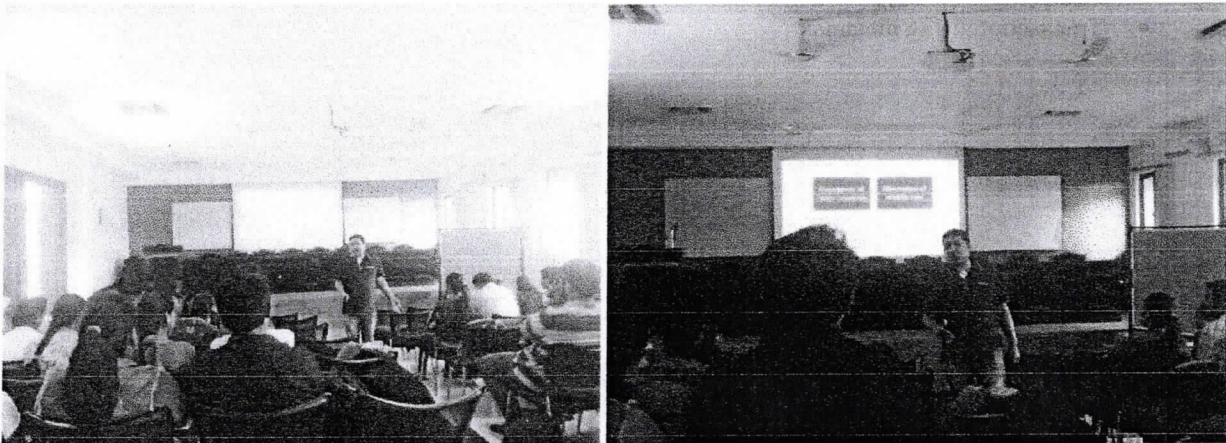
Why BLOCKCHAIN:-

Use case of BLOCKCHAIN:-

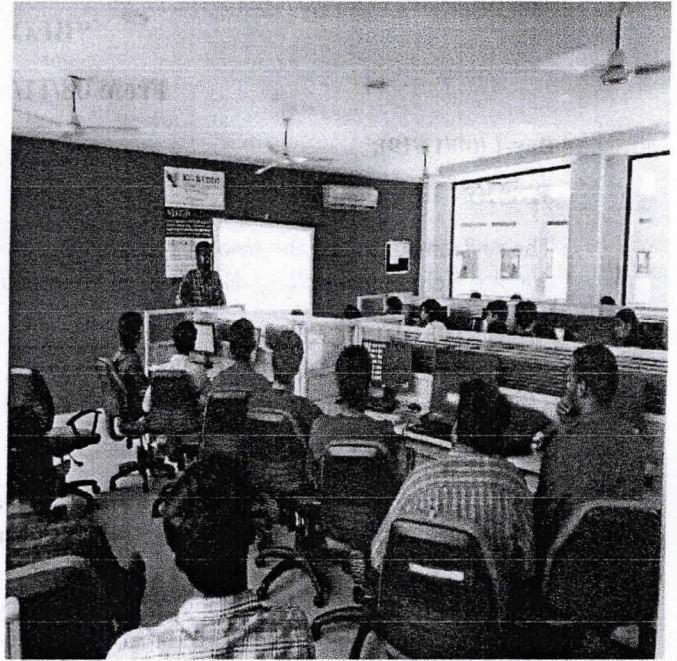
He has been discussed various use cases of block chain with students like,
