Hence, Finally our oath taking as Rotaractors in being board of directors is completed, and finally we ended the event with vote of thanks.

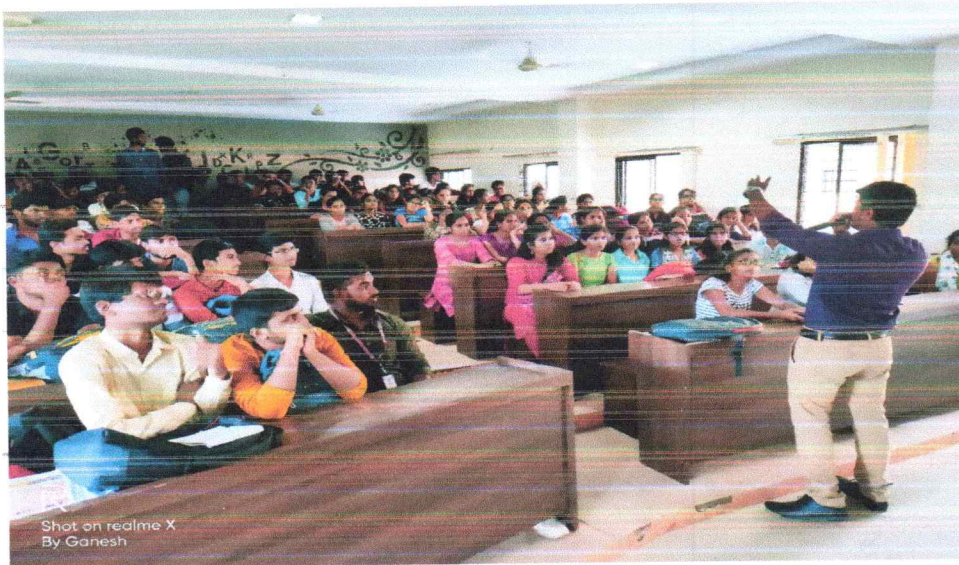
