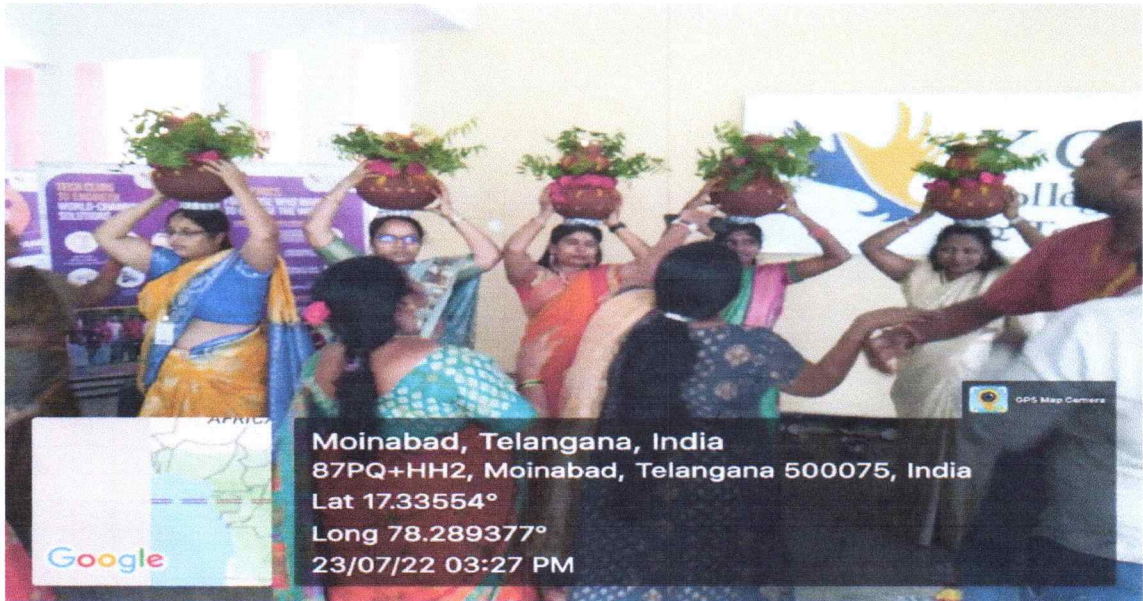

## A Summary Report

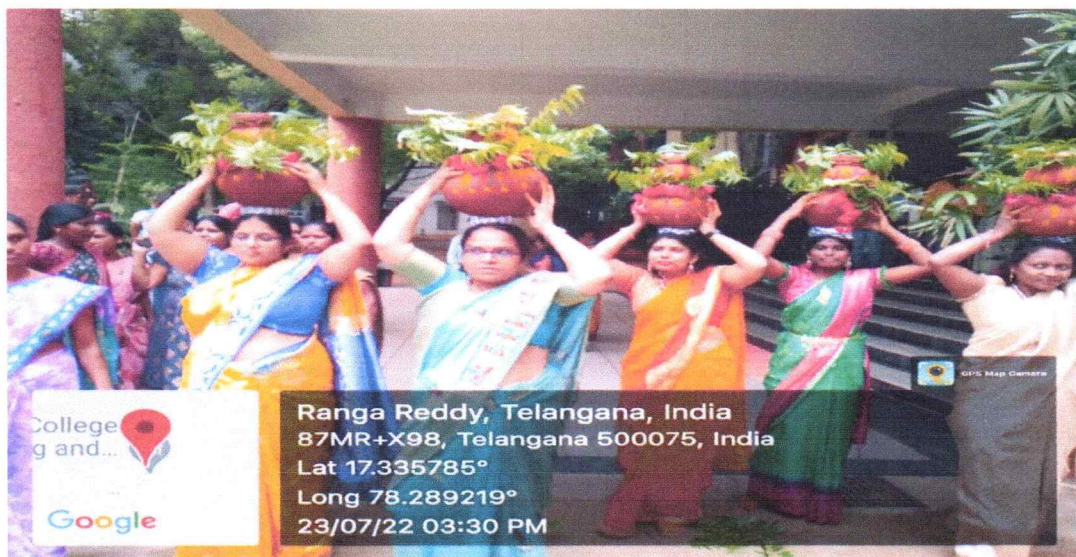
This Festival is celebrated in Telangana region. Goddess Mahankali is worshipped to guard evil and Protect us throught the year. **Bonalu** or Goddess Mahankali bonalu is a Hindu Festival, Goddess Maharani is worshiped.on Bonalu day, it is an annual festival of Telangana celebrated in Twin Cities Hyderabad, Secunderabad and other parts of Telangana. It is celebrated in the month of Ashadha Masam, in July/August. Special poojas are performed for Yellamma on the first and last day of the festival. The festival is also considered a thanks giving to the Goddess for fulfillment of vows. The word *Bonham* is a contraction of the word *Bhojanam*, a Sanskrit loanword which means a meal or a feast in Telugu, is an *Offering to Mother Goddess*. Women prepare rice cooked with milk and jiggery in a new Brass or Earthen Pot adorned with Neem leaves, turmeric, Vermilion and a lit lamp on the top of the Pot. Women carry the pots on their heads and make an offering of Bonam along with Turmeric-Vermilion,Bangles and Saree to the Mother Goddess across the Temples.Bonalu involves the worship of Mother Goddess in regionalformslike *Mysamma*, *Pochamma*, *Yellamma*, *Peddhamma*, *Dokkamma*, *Ankamma*, *Poleramma*, *Maremma*, *Nookamma*.

All the girl students and Women staff gathered in the Reception area near the Saraswathi idol at 3:00pm with the prepared Bonams, Decorated with Flowers and Neemleaves. Small pots were filled with Food offering prepared with rice ,milk and jiggery. A Deepam was placed atop.The Deans &HoDs performed pooja along with some other staff member. A few Lady faculty and ayammas carried Bonams on the Heads and processionled towards Main gate ,from there a college bus was ready to take them to the nearby temple.

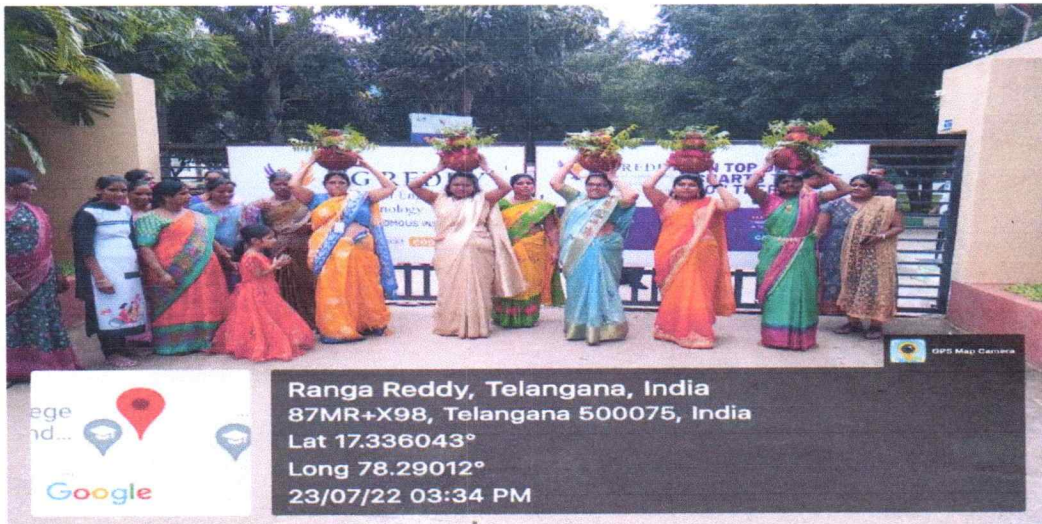
All these people came back to college After visiting the temple.The college busses at left at 4:30pm ending the Bonalu Celebrations.



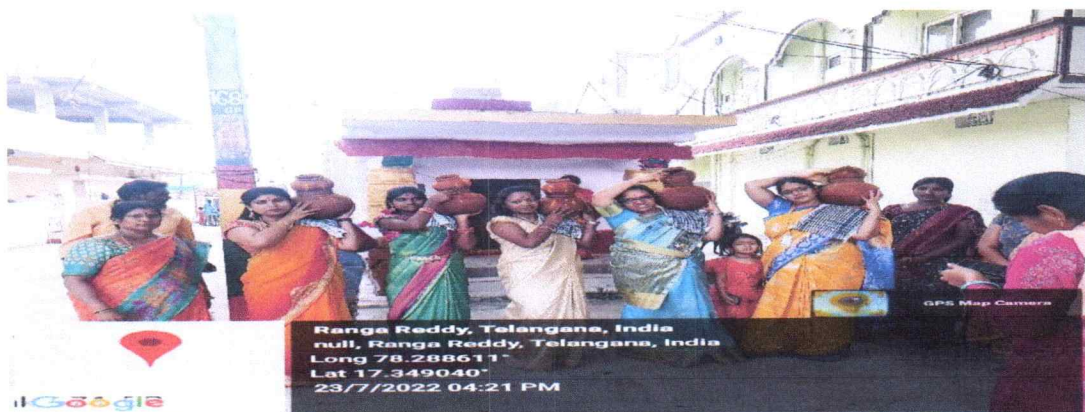
**Figure1:Group of Lady Faculty members ready with Bonam**

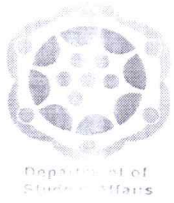
**Figure4: At the Temple**
