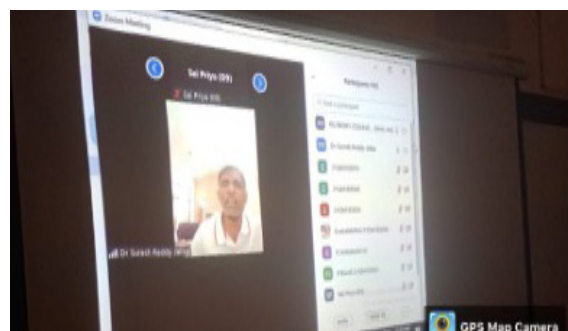

4. One day workshop on Rural ntrepreneurship -Sustainability and Rural Engagement was conducted on 13 -10- 2022.

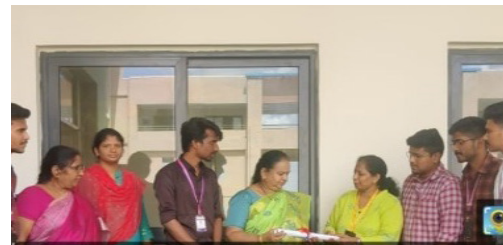
Dr. Naveen Kumar interacted on ' The Entrepreneurship And Rural Management '.

8. Orientation program for lateral entry students for all the branches was conducted on 28-10-2022.

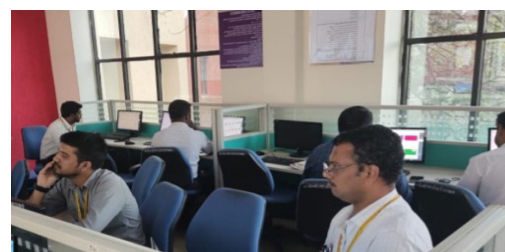
The Vision, Mission of the institution & all the departments were explained to sensitize the students about the environment where they are going to stay for 3 years more. All the Faculty members were introduced

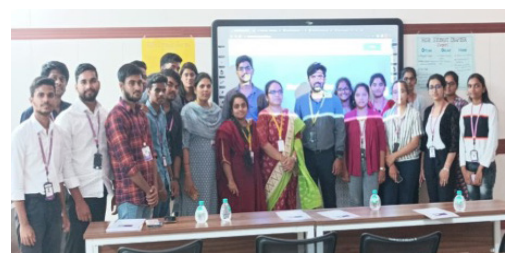
CENTRE FOR ENGINEERING EDUCATION & DEVELOPMENT (CEED)
